## Progress Updates

As mentioned in an earlier letter, staff are preparing short progress reports for your children which will be sent home on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> April. The purpose of these is to give you some information regarding how your child has settled back into school and into learning, to highlight some targets



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to focus on and to give you an indication of where your child is working against usual- pre-COVID-age related expectations. With the interruption to normal learning that has gone on this year, it will not be unusual for the children to have some gaps and the teachers are carefully adapting learning to support the children where needed.

## Premises News

A new external door has been added to Class 2 which will enable direct access to and from the Learning Garden. This will make the pathway to nursery less congested and will remove the need to use this area as an outdoor learning space for the children which although necessary, has not been ideal. Children from Class 1 and Class 2 will share the Learning Garden, using designated areas and equipment in order to maintain COVID safety. We know that this will make the garden busier at drop off and collection times so would ask that everyone does all they can to make space for others whilst waiting.

## Interactive Sports Wall

Over the holidays, work was completed on installing an interactive sports wall – or 'iWall' - in the KS2 hall. It is amazing! The video [HERE](#) will show you what an iWall is and give you an idea of how we can use it. The project has been funded through our PE and Sports Premium Grant which is an annual amount of money given to all primary schools solely for the purposes of enhancing and improving physical activity in school. Whilst we will use the iWall in PE lessons, we can also use it across the curriculum to promote rapid recall of all aspects of learning in a fun and active way. Staff will be accessing training on the new equipment over the next few weeks so that we can begin to use it with the children as soon as possible.

## Breakfast Club



Breakfast Club is back up and running and we have some spaces available for children in Nursery – Y6. The cost is £4 each day, including a great breakfast and we open from 7:30am.
