## Mathematics

In Autumn 2 we will be focusing on: Fractions and Multiplication and Division. Within fractions we will focus on equivalent fractions, improper fractions, compare fractions, order fractions and add and subtract fractions. Within Multiplication and Division, we will focus on 3 and 4 digits by 1 and 2 multiplication, short division, division with remainders and solving problems with taught techniques.

We will continue to complete our biweekly times tables test as well on a Friday.

## English

Our Writing lessons will be based on the novel The Boy in The Striped Pyjamas by John Boyne. We will write a diary entry a persuasive piece to persuade parents to evacuate their children and an eyewitness account

We will continue to have our weekly spelling test on a Friday. New spellings will be sent out after the spelling test.

#### Science

#### The Solar System

Pupils study our solar system, learning about the relative movements of the planets and the Moon and relating these to the way we experience the Sun and the Moon on Earth.

# PE

Dance and Gymnastics In this term we will be looking at a variety of movements within dance and gymnastics which includes counterbalances, canons, unisons and dancing using common movements.

### French La date

Days of the week, months of the year and numbers 1-31 will be introduced. By the end of this unit, pupils will have the knowledge and skills to say the date and when their birthday is in French.

## **Religious Education** Why are the Gospel accounts of Christmas different?

In this unit we will look at different versions of the Nativity from the gospels and discuss why they are all so different.

## **PSHCE** Safety

Pupils will look at how to be stay safe with prescription drugs, the negative effects of tobacco, how substances can be abused and basic first aid.

## History Could you keep calm and carry on?

We will continue to look at World War 2 in History. We will focus on how the war came to an end and the significant battles that took place.
